Where the role fits

This role is part of the Operations Team, that is responsible for the operational delivery of all products and services, across all customer groups and geographies.

The role of the Operations team is to define and deliver the operational strategy that enables the delivery of high-quality, cost-effective services, providing input into the product roadmap, with the Portfolio and Product Management team (PPM) and the Engagement and Growth team (E&G).

The Operations team are responsible for driving continuous improvement of processes, workflows, solutions and services, making use of advances in technology, whilst effectively managing outsourced services, to deliver efficient and effective continuous process improvements that minimises cost and risk to organisation as a whole.

Purpose of the role

The Junior Videographer supports the delivery of high-quality video production and streaming services for both internal and external stakeholders. This role assists in creating a range of video content that aligns with IET's objectives, highlighting engineering achievements and supporting the organisation's impact. Working closely with the team, the Junior Videographer helps produce edited engaging multimedia content, contributing to production workflows, operating technical equipment, and maintaining high standards across all projects.

Main duties and responsibilities (not necessarily in priority order)

- Work with the Production Manager and Broadcast Engineer to support and complete the editing of promotions, conferences, and internal editing requests.
- Assist in editing larger video production content to meet project briefs and quality requirements.
- Participate in the post-production process, helping to maintain quality control and support workflow efficiency.
- Download, organise, and prepare footage for editing according to IET Video Services best practices.
- Support the delivery of final edits that meet project requirements and are suitable for different platforms and formats.
- Perform basic colour grading tasks and basic audio processing tasks.
- Follow established post-production workflows and guidelines.
- Assist with capturing, recording, editing, and streaming video content from IET and third-party venues as required.
- Support the use of recording equipment for down-the-line recordings, capturing online interviews and live
 presentations for in-person and remote audiences.

- Provide support to the Broadcast and Technical Manager and the Broadcast Engineer as well as IET
 Video Services team in setting up and operating cameras, lighting, audio, and other AV equipment.
- Help set up, record and edit IET Video Services content, including single and multi-camera shoots, vox pops, and interviews.
- Support adherence to IET Video Services standards and style guidelines for third-party content.
- Update project boards as directed and ensure work is regularly backed up.
- Help maintain equipment and report any issues to ensure optimal performance.
- Work collaboratively with IET colleagues to troubleshoot equipment and uphold production standards.
- Operate recording and streaming equipment, including Tricasters and Zoom, for various broadcast needs under supervision.
- Assist in monitoring live streaming events to ensure smooth broadcasts and record feeds as required for client us.
- Any other duties as are reasonable as per the skill and experience of the post-holder.

- Deliver high-quality support services: You'll be responsible for delivering a wide range of essential tasks and services that ensure the smooth day-to-day running of the IET.

- A strong interest in editing with experience in video production and live streaming, alongside a basic understanding of video and broadcast equipment and a willingness to learn troubleshooting skills.
- Familiarity with Adobe Creative Cloud products is desirable with emphasis being on Premiere Pro and After Effects.
- Attention to detail and the ability to follow standard guidelines.
- Willingness to work out of hours, travel, and adapt to the needs of live events, maintaining a professional and customer-focused approach.
